Subject: Coastal Operation Update - September 2022


Executive Summary

- While the 2021/22 season officially ended on Friday 29 April 2022, annual statistics are recorded in line with the financial year (ending 30 June 2022). Across the year, RCC patrolled beaches saw a significant reduction in visitors compared to previous seasons, with a total of 8.5 million visitors to Clovelly, Coogee and Maroubra. This is compared to:
 - Over 9 million in the 2020/21 season (~6% reduction); &
 - Approximately 9.5 million in 2019/20 (~11% less).
- While attendance was down 'Rescues' have remained significantly high, with 540 rescues during the 2021/22 beach season, compared to:
 - 418 rescues during the 2020/21 (~30% more); &
 - 306 rescues in 2019/20 (~76% increase).
- 'Major Incidents' finished noticeably down in 2021/22, with 155 major incidents compared to:
 - 243 throughout the 2020/21 season (~36% less); &
 - 236 in 2019/20 (~34% reduction).
- "Regulatory" work by the lifeguards (a combination of 'Preventions', 'Regulations' and 'Surf craft Warnings') totaled 47,739 throughout 2021/22, compared to:
 - 54,448 during the 2020/21 season (just over 12% reduction); &
 - 57,052 in the 2019/20 season (approximately 16% less).
- The 2022/23 beach season officially starts on Saturday 24 September 2022, with RCC's season wrapping up on Friday 5 May 2023. As always, the week prior to the season commencing (19-23 September) is Randwick's "Beach Front" where lifeguards complete their recertifications along with other training to best prepare themselves up for the season ahead.
- Technology continues to improve and receive upgrades along the RCC coastline, with several changes/additions expected for the 2022/23 season:
 - CCTV at Gordon's Bay is being upgraded.
 - A Smart Beaches board has now been installed at Maroubra beach.
 - Two Emergency Response Beacons (ERB's) are being purchased and installed at Malabar and Little Bay.
- The foil boarding report was put on hold for the remainder of the 2021/22 season, to assess the behaviour of foil boarders and how they responded to RCC lifeguard instruction not to foil during patrol hours. This trial supports a partial ban of foil boarding (aligned with the Council Policy for kitesurfing) as opposed to an outright ban.

Across the year, RCC patrolled beaches saw a significant reduction in visitors compared to previous seasons, with a total of 8.5 million visitors to Clovelly, Coogee and Maroubra. This is compared to:
 - Over 9 million in the 2020/21 season (~6% reduction); &
 - Approximately 9.5 million in 2019/20 (~11% less).
2. While attendance was down 'Rescues' have remained significantly high, with 540 rescues during the 2021/22 beach season, compared to:
 - 418 rescues during the 2020/21 (~30% more); &
 - 306 rescues in 2019/20 (~76% increase).
3. 'Major Incidents' finished noticeably down in 2021/22, with 155 major incidents compared to:
 - 243 throughout the 2020/21 season (~36% less); &
 - 236 in 2019/20 (~34% reduction).
4. "Regulatory" work by the lifeguards (i.e. a combination of 'Preventions', 'Regulations' and 'Surf craft Warnings') totalled 47,739 throughout 2021/22, compared to:
 - 54,448 during the 2020/21 season (just over 12% reduction); &
 - 57,052 in the 2019/20 season (approximately 16% less).
5. Following the fatal shark attack at Little Bay in February 2022, there were no further fatalities along the RCC coastline with a total of 3 water-based and 2 other fatalities during the 2021/22 season.
 - 21/12/21 - male self-harm (Waverley), body retrieved near Clovelly
 - 08/01/22 - male fell from cliffs at Coogee (Dolphin Point)
 - 31/01/22 - father and son rock fishing at Little Bay (The Gutter)
 - 16/02/22 - shark attack at Little Bay (Julianne's)

Beach Lifeguard update for the 2021/22 Season

- The 2022/23 beach season officially starts on Saturday 24 September 2022, with RCC's season wrapping up on Friday 5 May 2023. As always, the week prior to the season commencing (19-23 September) is Randwick's "Beach Front" where lifeguards complete their recertifications along with other training to best prepare themselves up for the season ahead.
 - NB: this year Permanent and Seasonal lifeguards will attend a 2-day Mental Health First Aid course.
- As with any pre-season, the Randwick beach lifeguard service has been busy procuring new plant equipment and onboarding new lifeguards ready for the busy beach season ahead.
 - Included in the new equipment is a jet ski at Maroubra, as well as an eBike for Clovelly following the successful trial during the 2021/22 season.
 - The service is currently recruiting a replacement full-time beach lifeguard, but has already employed 3x new Seasonal beach lifeguards (1x internal candidate) and 3x new casual beach lifeguards.
- The next Randwick City Council and Surf Life Saving operations meeting will be a face-to-face 'Meet & Greet' with the Club Captains joining the RCC beach lifeguards on Wednesday 21 September, during the RCC Beach Front training week. This will be a great way for those 'on the sand' to get to know each other's faces and discuss the upcoming season, so both RCC and SLS are again working cohesively alongside each other.



- Technology continues to improve and receive upgrades along the RCC coastline, with several changes/additions expected for the 2022/23 season:
 - CCTV at Gordon's Bay is being upgraded from solar to hard-wired power, to increase reliability and remove components that are not tolerating the harsh conditions.
 - A Smart Beaches board similar to the one at Coogee has now been installed at Maroubra beach to provide accurate, real-time information for beach users.
 - Two Emergency Response Beacons (ERB's) are being purchased and installed at Malabar and Little Bay. ERB's are solar powered and have both a camera and communications link, which is connected directly to the NSW SLS State Operations Centre (which is manned 24/7). The ERB's will provide an additional resource to assist with contacting emergency services and reducing the response times to incidents.
- Another La Nina weather pattern is expected for the coming summer, which will bring with it plenty of rain. This will be the third La Nina summer in a row, which will most likely keep visitation rates to the beaches down.
- Board-rider groups will finish their season in early October, with Nippers starting again from middle-end of October. Hopefully COVID restrictions will remain relaxed so Nippers can enjoy their first "uninterrupted" season in approximately 3-years.
- RCC beach lifeguards have spent the winter revamping the 'Beach and Surf Safety Education Program', ready to deliver to approximately 20 schools from October – November. New content and video has been collated to ensure the information being delivered to local school children is up to date, meaningful and most importantly, *interesting* for children aged 10-12 years. *Larry the Lifeguard* received a facelift in 2021, so is ready to join the team delivering the program to schools.
- Randwick City Council will host the inaugural NSW Local Government Coastal Safety Group (CSG) conference on 26-27 October. Day one of the conference will be held at the Prince Henry Centre, with water safety experts and industry leaders presenting to the attendees from various coastal councils. Day two will be conducted at Maroubra Beach, where professional Council lifeguards will be put through a wide range of practical training sessions by authorised training organisations.
- A report regarding foil boarding along the Randwick City Council coastline was put on hold for the remainder of the 2021/22 season, to assess the behaviour of foil boarders and how they responded to RCC lifeguard instruction not to foil during patrol hours. Overall, this trial was successful, supporting a partial ban of foil boarding (aligned with the Council Policy for kitesurfing) as opposed to an outright ban. The Risk Assessment is being updated, after which a meeting will be scheduled between Council and the foil boarding community, before a report is then submitted to Council.

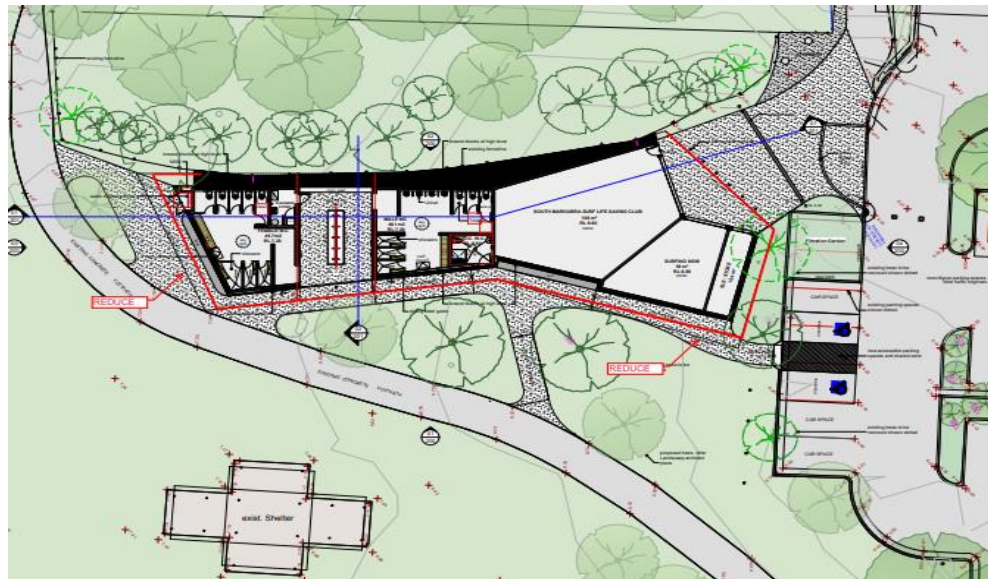

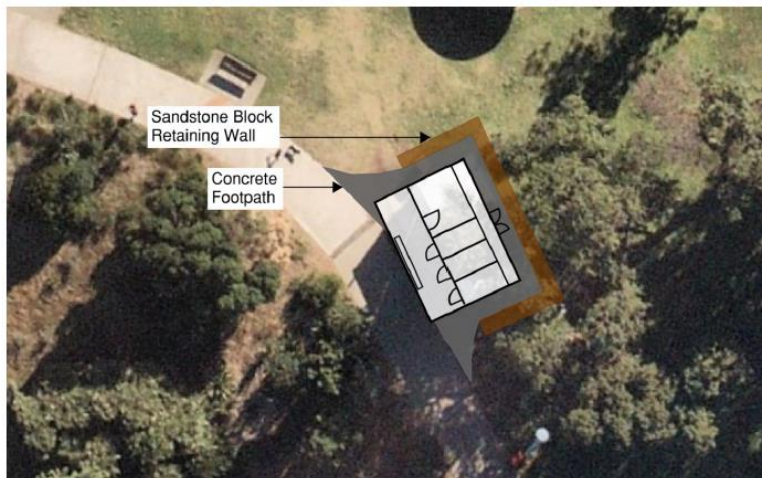


Figure 5 Proposed Layout

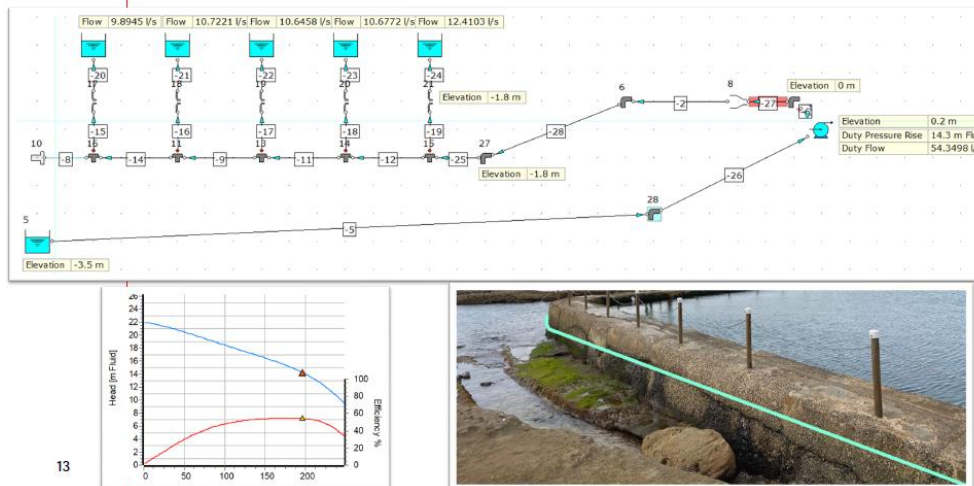

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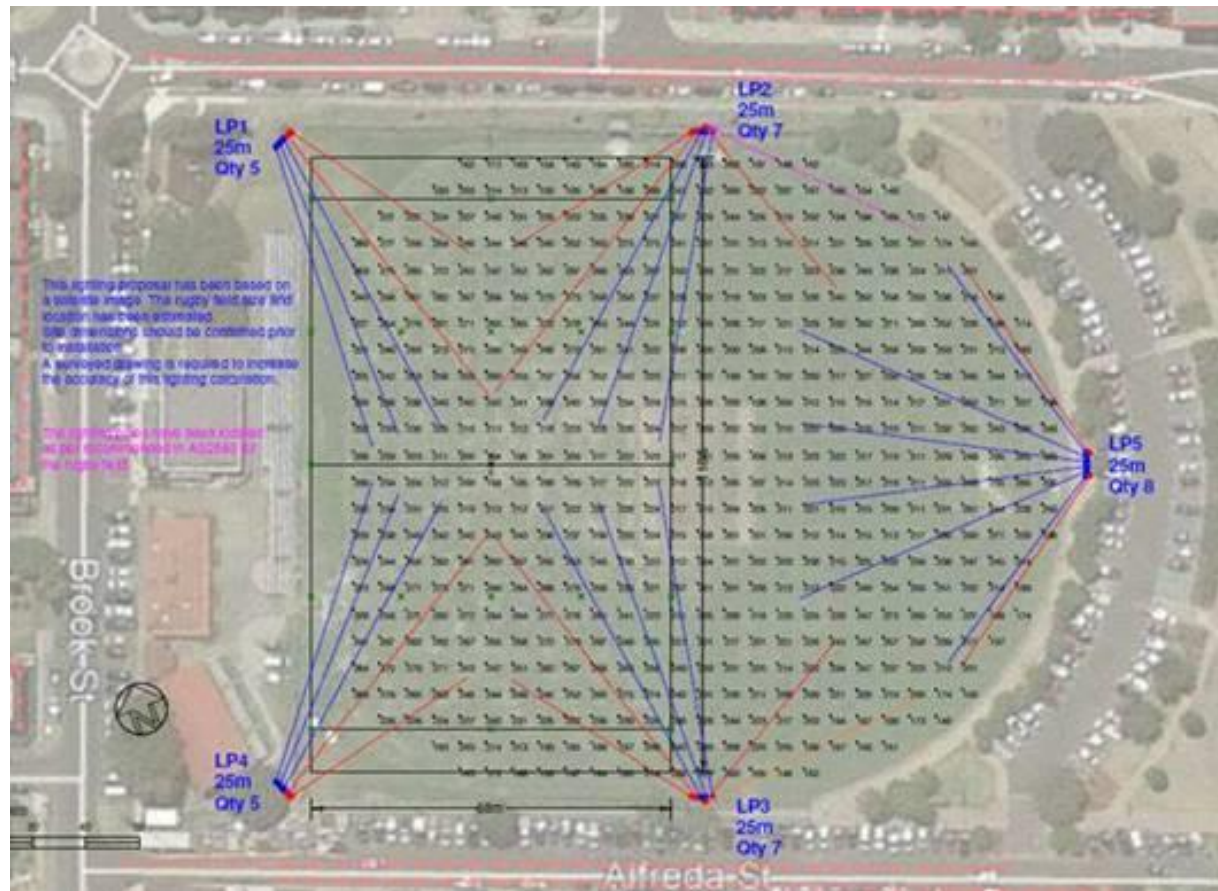
