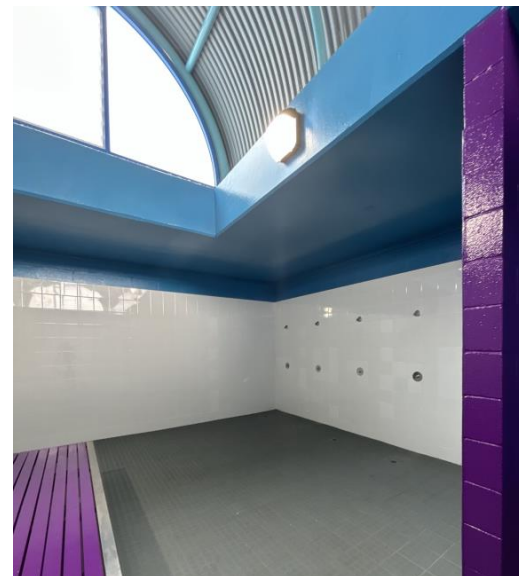

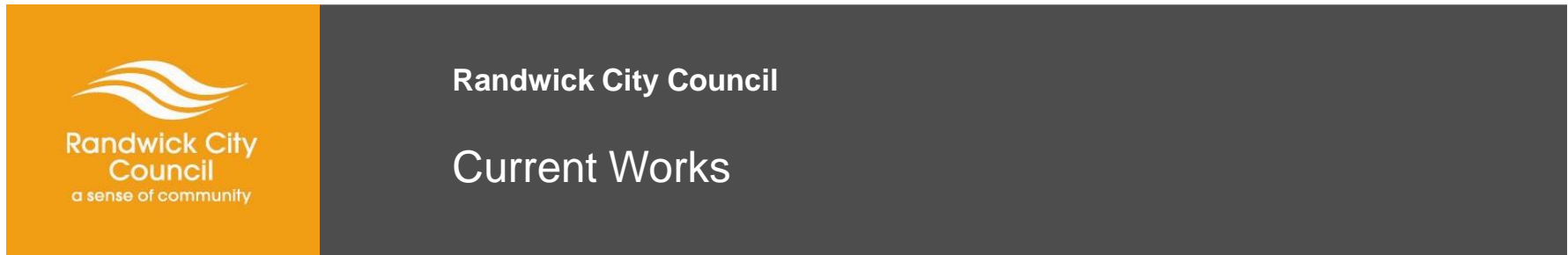

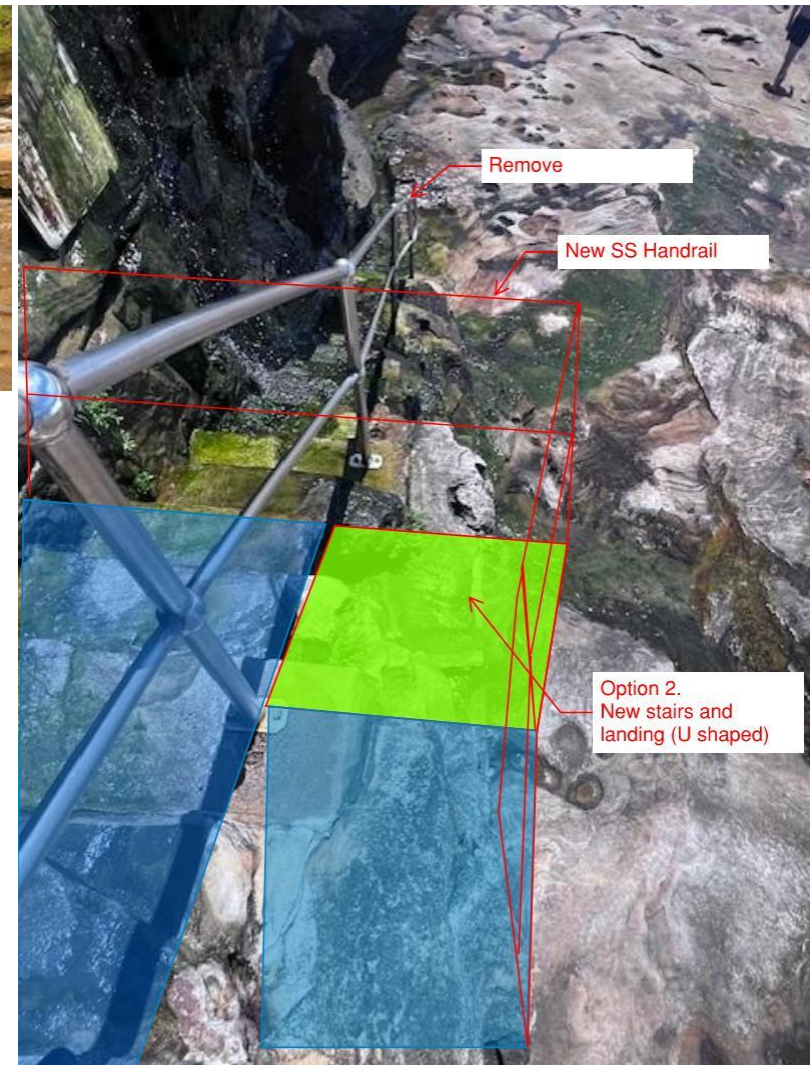

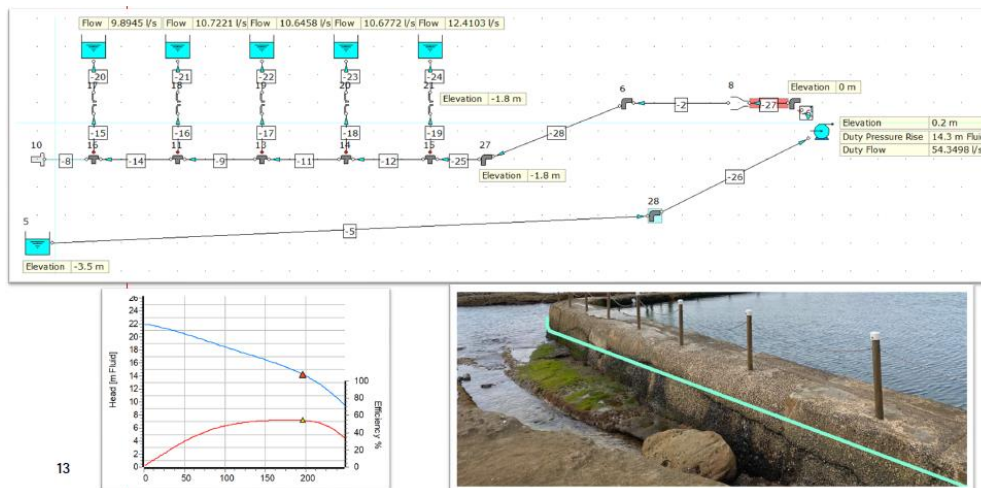

- Interpretive signage and information about Randwick's local birds and fauna

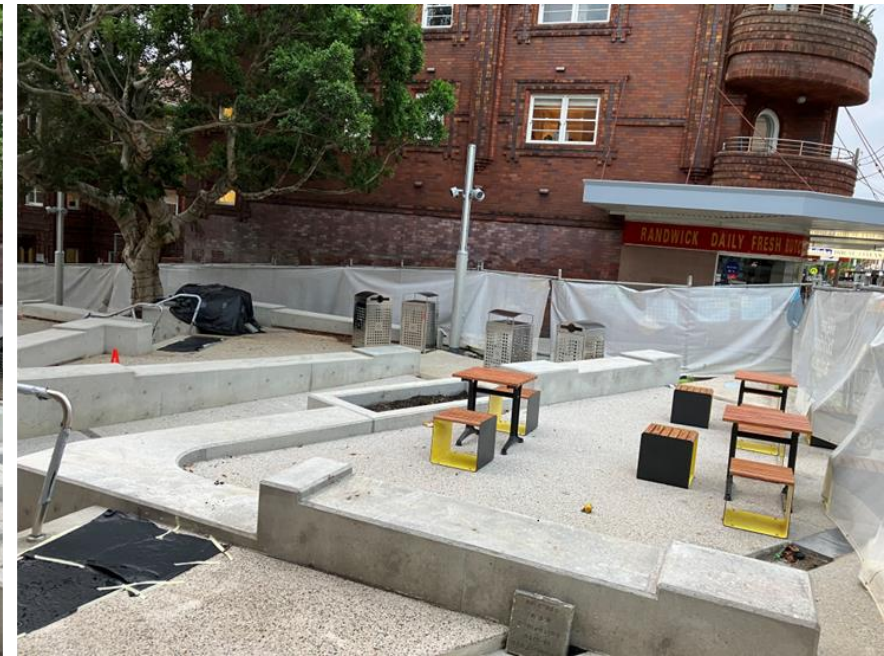

## Coastal Advisory Report No. CAC3/24

**Subject:** Coastal Operation Update - March 2024

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### Executive Summary

- Last quarter (December- February 2024), the lifeguard team have conducted 335 rescues, reflecting a decrease from the 510 rescues performed during the same period last year.
- 66 major incidents along the coastline including medical emergencies, search and rescue operations and Police requested.
- The introduction of lifeguard patrols at Malabar and Little Bay beaches has gained positive feedback from stakeholders. The lifeguard patrols at these locations have now concluded.
- Significant events involve two near-drowning situations at Maroubra Beach. Three swimmers jumped into a rip at South Maroubra, resulting in one swimmer getting into trouble.  
The lifeguard successfully retrieved the first patient and unexpectedly had to rescue another distressed swimmer. Additional lifeguards observed a person floating at a greater distance, a lifeguard swiftly retrieved the individual, initiating CPR. Paramedics and police arrived on the scene, and despite initial challenges, a pulse was detected before the patient was transported to the hospital.
- The second incident involved lifeguards responding to a patient supported by bystanders on the pool wall at the western end of the bay. The patient was dragged to safety, and CPR was administered. Paramedics arrived promptly, and the patient, with a detected pulse and breathing, was transported to the hospital for further medical intervention.
